- Resolve conflicts calmly by seeking the support of the school leadership team.
- Refrain from using aggressive language or behaviour at drop-off, pick-up, or school events.
- Lead by example, demonstrating the values of respect and patience that we instil in our children.

Adults play a crucial role in supporting children develop self-regulation skills, especially in stressful situations. Additionally, it is everyone's responsibility to model respectful interactions through our own behaviour, demonstrating how to communicate with kindness, set boundaries and resolve conflicts in a constructive manner.

The safety and well-being of our school community are our top priorities. Any continued instances of inappropriate behaviour will result in further action, including restrictions accessing the school site.
