‘Let’s go home,’ says Dad.

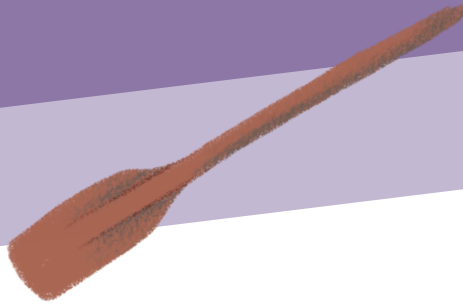
‘See you next week, Flo?’ asks Anna.
