‘Nice one, Tess! You must be proud. You made great time,’ said her coach, as he gave her a medal and a high five.



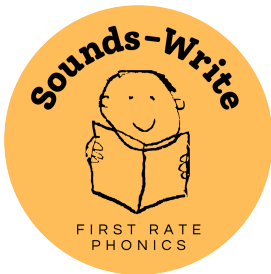
Back home, Tess hung the prize in her room with pride.
