

The children learn skills such as pencil control, cutting and sticking and modelling with 3D materials, often taking inspiration form artisits, such as Kandinski. This forms the basis for the art curriculum followed by the children from Year 1 onwards. The art activities typically take place in small groups led by an adult with children experimenting, collborating and discussing their ideas during the sessions.
